10. 2015 Chair's report: Please provide a narrative of the past year's activity/successes/challenges:*	In past year, we have successfully established our flagship program, Global Innovative Challenges in collaboration with Universiti Technology Malaysia (UTM). This is the second time we have run this program successfully and last year we have received participation from our neighbour country, Indonesia. In collaboration with Universiti Sains Malaysia (USM), we have run a series of outreach activity engaged high school students to promote chemistry as their career pathway. Moreover, we have also supported two mega 'carnival-liked' events at state level, namely Penang International Science Festival and also Chemistry Carnival Johor". The turnout rate for these two events has exceeded 10,000 people! In addition, PISF activity was assisted by the USM Student Chapter. Besides, we have co-organized with School of Chemical Sciences, USM on International Conference of Young Chemists (ICYC2015) and saw the presence of many participants from various countries. Furthermore, by working with University Putra Malaysia, our chapter also involved in supporting the 27th Regional Symposium of Malaysia Analytical Sciences. In collaboration with Academy Science Malaysia, 3 of our chapter officers also served on the question committee (under chemistry division) for National Science Challenges (NSC) 2015. NSC is a national level competition involved more than 20,000 high school students.

	career pathway to the young generation. Approximately, more than 300 high school students have benefitted from this activity. In addition, in conjunction with our chapter mission on outreach, we have also supported two mega carnival-like event, namely Carnival Chemistry Johor and Penang International Science Festival, in cooperation with state government and also Academy Science Malaysia (ASM). These two events has attracted more than 1,000 visitors to our booth and learned about ACS Malaysia, more importantly, chemistry in general. On Sept 28, 2015 we have successfully organized our flagship program, South East Asian Global Innovation Challenges (SEA-GIC), with theme focused on Sustainable Approaches for Global Water Security. This competition not only attracted participants from more than 10 universities in Malaysia but also from our neighbouring country, Indonesia. Through this program, it is our intention to facilitate soft-skills development among the local graduate and at the same time promote critical thinking to use chemistry knowledge to solve problems related to water security. This vision is welly aligned with the focus of International Year of Chemistry 2011 which is to highlight the role of chemistry in solving global problem. Moreover, our chapter has also successfully co-organized International Conference of Young Chemist 2015. Again, this conference provides an effective platform to foster exchange of idea and information related to chemistry among the young chemist and at the same time allow ACS members to get together. Furthermore, our chapter has also supported the 28th Regional Symposium of Malaysian Analytical Sciences which is spearheaded by our advisory board members.		
	With assistance from our chapter, Universiti Sains Malaysia has successfully established its own ACS student chapter. Together with their advisors, three student members from this newly established USM student chapter, have attended 250th ACS National Meeting at Boston. In fact, not only our student members has branched out from Malaysia, two of our chapter members have also supported ACS activity in Thailand by servicing as facilitator in Building Opportunity out of Science (BOOST) Trainer Institute. Besides, our chapter has also hosted various visits by our colleagues from ACS International Office and support their activity in promoting ACS to local community. In view of our active engagement and contribution to the international activity of ACS, our chapter has also been conferred with Salutes to Excellence Award and P3 Award in 2015.
